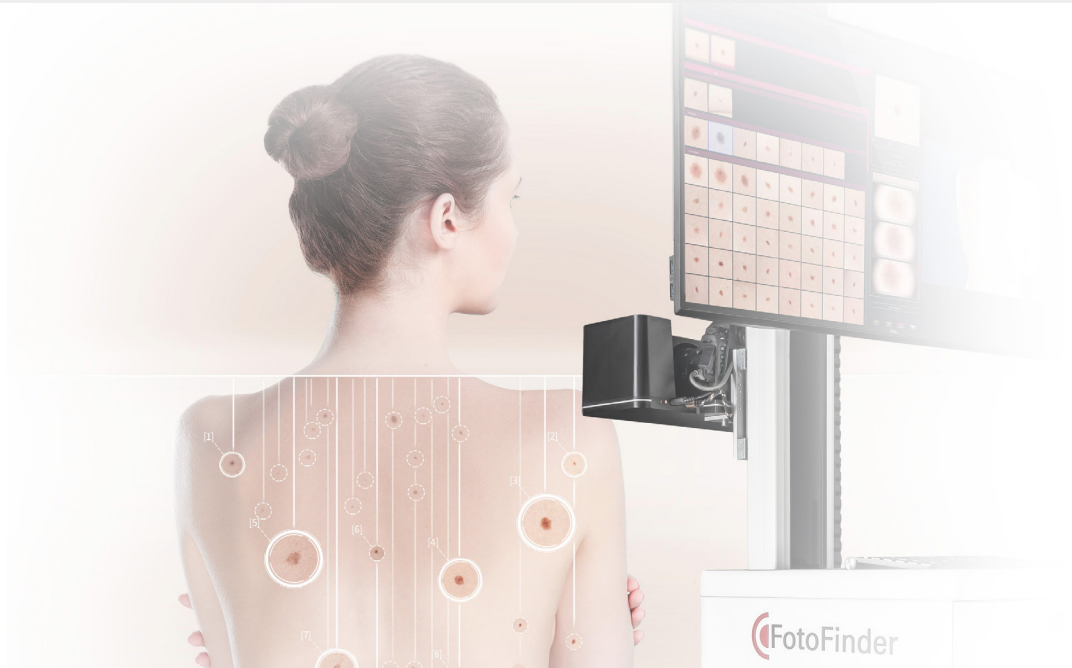


Computerised Total Body Photography



TOTAL BODY PHOTOGRAPHY

Is the process of taking a set of standardised high quality images that map your entire skin surface.

This enables computer assisted comparison of all your lesions.

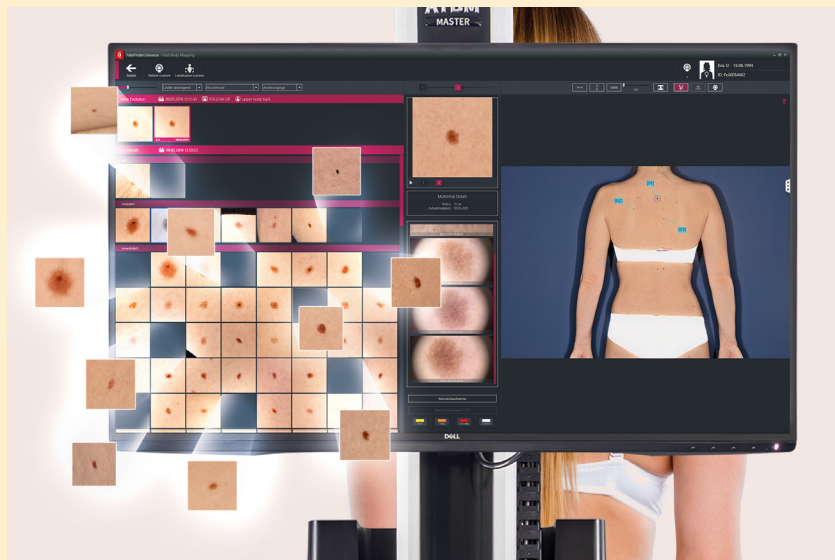
Whilst the computer does not diagnose, it readily identifies new and changed lesions for extra attention. This is important as it has been shown that these may be of concern, even if they look harmless on clinical examination.

Total Body Photography should be highly considered if you have one of the following:

- ✓ You have a personal or family history of **MELANOMA** and/or **SKIN CANCER**
- ✓ You have many **MOLES** or **FRECKLES**

In addition there may be other factors to consider, including age, skin type and sun exposure, which your doctor will discuss with you to ensure you have the best possible treatment.

If you feel you are a high risk patient and would like to discuss this further or **book an appointment** for the Total Body Photography process, please contact the clinic.



What to expect at your appointment:

- ✓ Photography is conducted in a dedicated room by a trained staff member.
- ✓ You will be required to undress to your underwear (or swimwear, if you prefer).
- ✓ The process takes approximately 20 minutes .
- ✓ The images are saved to your patient file for your doctor to review.
- ✓ This service will incur an extra fee of \$50. (No Medicare rebate)
